

## Performance during March, 2018

- (i) Commission advised issuance of sanction for prosecution in respect of **9** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (ii) Prosecution sanctions were issued by the Competent Authorities in respect of **8** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iii) Commission advised initiation of major penalty proceedings against **62** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iv) Commission advised imposition of major penalty against **2** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organization.
- (v) On the advice of the Commission, the Competent Authorities imposed major penalties in respect of **83** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations.
- (vi) Commission processed **1772** complaints (including **79** whistle blower complaints) during the month and sought investigation report in **40** complaints from the concerned Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (vii) Intensive Examination of **06** works carried out by Chief Technical Examiner's Organization resulted in recoveries to the tune of **Rs. 442.79 lakh** during **March, 2018**.
- (viii) Commission provided inputs in respect of **20** cases for vigilance clearance of officials for Board level appointments in CPSE's. In addition, references of **187** officials of All India Services and Central Services were considered for vigilance clearance in matters of empanelment, promotion etc. and inputs provided by the Commission.
- (ix) **14** officers were considered for appointment/empanelment/extension as full time/part time CVOs in various organizations and recommendations were given by the Commission.

- (i) Shri K.V. Chowdary, CVC, inaugurated 5<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration of Vigilance Study Circle, Kerala on 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2018 hosted by Cochin Shipyard Ltd. The CVC in his inaugural address reaffirmed the significance of Preventive Vigilance in reduction of corruption & promotion of transparency & emphasized the attributes of probity in the conduct of public servants.
- (ii) The Central Vigilance Commission's monthly lecture was delivered by Dr. Ajay Bhushan Pandey, CEO, UIDAI on the topic "**Aadhaar – Tool for Empowerment and Transparency**" on 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2018.
