

Performance during January, 2013

- (i) Commission advised issuance of sanction for prosecution in respect of **17** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations during the month which include an IPS officer (an Inspector General of Police, Tamil Nadu) and the then Vice Chancellor, Indian Maritime University.
- (ii) Prosecution sanctions were issued by the Competent Authorities in respect of **11** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations during the month which includes one IAS officer who was Managing Director, Orissa Rural Housing Development Corporation (ORHDC) and a Financial Advisor & Chief Accounts Officer from Ministry of Railways.
- (iii) Commission processed **3211** complaints (including **86** whistle blower complaints) during the month and sought investigation/factual report in **108** complaints from the concerned Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iv) Commission advised initiation of major penalty proceedings against **144** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations which include the then Vice Chancellor, Indian Maritime University, eleven General Managers from Industrial Development Bank of India (IDBI), one General Manager each from Punjab National Bank, Bharat Coking Coal Ltd. and South Eastern Coalfields Ltd.
- (v) Commission advised imposition of major penalty against **26** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations, which include a General Manager level officer (i.e. Director (Medical & Health Services) of Steel Authority of India Ltd., a General Manager from Syndicate Bank, a General Manager from UCO Bank and two Superintending Engineers from Damodar Valley Corporation.
- (vi) On the advice of the Commission, the Competent Authorities imposed major penalties in respect of **67** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations, which include an Executive Director from Metallurgical Engg. Consultants India, two Scientists (Grade-E) of Bureau of Indian Standards, a Chief Medical Officer from Department of Health and a General Manager from Syndicate Bank.

- (vii) The intensive examination by Chief Technical Examiner's Organization resulted in recoveries to the tune of **Rs. 1,09,68,839/-** during the month of January, 2013.
- (viii) Commission processed 24 matters for vigilance clearance of officials for Board level appointments in CPSEs. In addition, references of 264 All India Services and Central Services officers were considered for vigilance clearance in matter of empanelment etc.
- (ix) 37 officers were considered for appointment/empanelment as full time CVOs in various organizations.

B. Important activities:

- (i) Shri R.Sri Kumar, Vigilance Commissioner released a book titled "Corruption- The Rot Within" written by Y.G. Muralidharan, at a function held on 20th January, 2013 at Bengaluru. In this book, an attempt has been made to understand the concept of corruption, its history, causes for corruption and the measures to eradicate corruption.
- (ii) Shri J.M. Garg, Vigilance Commissioner presided over a Lecture-cum-discussion session on 'Contract Management - Pitfalls and Precautions' organized by Central Warehousing Corporation on 24th January, 2013. Shri Anil Singhal, Chief Technical Examiner, CVC and Shri Salim Haque, Addl. Secretary, CVC also attended and addressed the participants.
