

## Performance during December, 2014

- (i) Commission advised issuance of sanction for prosecution in respect of **20** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations during the month which include an IAS officer, three Joint Commissioners of Income Tax, Central Board of Direct Taxes, a Senior General Manager from Department of Telecommunications and a General Manager from Bank of India.
- (ii) Prosecution sanctions were issued by the Competent Authorities in respect of **8** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations during the month which include three IRS officers from Central Board of Direct Taxes.
- (iii) Commission advised initiation of major penalty proceedings against **173** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations which include a Chairman and Managing Director of General Insurance Corporation of India, an Executive Director of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., four Regional Provident Fund Commissioners from Employees Provident Fund Organization, two IRS officers from Central Board of Direct Taxes, a General Manager of UCO Bank, a General Manager of Central Bank of India, a General Manager of Andhra Bank, two Directors from Indian Council of Agricultural Research and a Chief General Manager from Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd.
- (iv) Commission advised imposition of major penalty against **42** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations, which include a Director from Indian Council of Agricultural Research, a Group(E) Scientist of Bureau of Indian Standards and an officer from Indian Defence Accounts Services in CGDA.
- (v) On the advice of the Commission, the Competent Authorities imposed major penalties in respect of **53** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations, which include two General Managers from Central Coalfields Ltd., two General Managers from Manganese Ore India Ltd., an Executive Director and two General Managers from National Hydro-Electric Power Corporation Ltd. .
- (vi) Commission processed **14630** complaints (including **97** whistle blower complaints) during the month and sought investigation/factual report in **55** complaints from the concerned Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (vii) Intensive Examination of **03** works carried out by Chief Technical Examiner's Organization resulted in recoveries to the tune of **₹ 431.62 lakhs** during December, 2014.
- (viii) Commission provided inputs in respect of **27** cases for vigilance clearance of officials for Board level appointments in CPSE's. In addition, references of **281** officials of All India Services and Central Services were considered for vigilance clearance in matters of empanelment, promotion etc. and inputs provided by the Commission.
- (ix) **24** officers were considered for appointment/empanelment as full time/part time CVOs in various organizations and recommendations were given by the Commission.
