

## Performance during February, 2018

- (i) Commission advised issuance of sanction for prosecution in respect of **2** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (ii) Prosecution sanctions were issued by the Competent Authorities in respect of **11** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iii) Commission advised initiation of major penalty proceedings against **93** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iv) Commission advised imposition of major penalty against **3** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organization.
- (v) On the advice of the Commission, the Competent Authorities imposed major penalties in respect of **68** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations.
- (vi) Commission processed **1976** complaints (including **13** whistle blower complaints) during the month and sought investigation report in **22** complaints from the concerned Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (vii) Intensive Examination of **07** works carried out by Chief Technical Examiner's Organization resulted in recoveries to the tune of **Rs. 36.89 lakh** during **February, 2018**.
- (viii) Commission provided inputs in respect of **36** cases for vigilance clearance of officials for Board level appointments in CPSE's. In addition, references of **295** officials of All India Services and Central Services were considered for vigilance clearance in matters of empanelment, promotion etc. and inputs provided by the Commission.
- (ix) **22** officers were considered for appointment/empanelment/extension as full time/part time CVOs in various organizations and recommendations were given by the Commission.
